

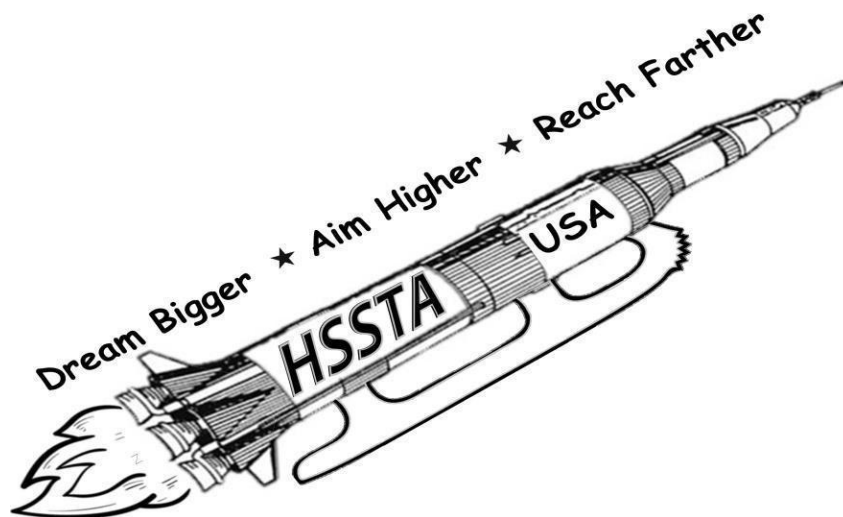

6th Annual Dream Bigger, Aim Higher, Reach Farther ISI Team Competition

September 18 - September 20, 2026

Eligibility: This Competition is open to all individual ISI members – all ages (Tots through Adults!). Membership must be current through September 18, 2026. All skaters must represent a current ISI Administrative Member. Proof of ISI membership is required for all competitors. *Skaters may only compete at their highest test levels registered with ISI by August 16, 2026.*

Registration: Competitors are required to check-in at the registration desk at least one hour before their first event. Proof of ISI membership should be presented at this time.

Competition Standards: The Dream Bigger, Aim Higher, Reach Farther Competition will be using rules and regulations from the **2026 ISI Handbook**. Rule Revisions are available on the ISI website www.skateisi.org. All skaters, coaches and parents should be familiar with the performance rules for each event.

Entry Forms and Entry Deadline: Entry forms should be mailed or turned into the Huntsville Skating School & Training Academy. **Entry deadline is August 16, 2026.** The coach or rink manager should also review each form to verify that all information is correct. Late entries must be approved by the Competition Director. There will be a \$50.00 late fee charged to all late applications that are accepted. There will be no refunds.

Entry Fees:

Single Entries: \$60.00 first event - \$20.00 each additional event

Family Entries: \$100.00 for a total of 3 events - \$20.00 each additional event

Team Events: \$15.00 per skater

Late Entries: \$50.00 additional if allowed by Competition Director

Music: Music must be EMAILED to hssta@icesportscenter.com. Music (MP3 or MP4 format) must be identified with skater name, event name and rink name (e.g. Jane Smith_ Freestyle 2 Lt Ent_ ABC Rink). **DEADLINE for emailed music is September 12, 2026.** Competitors must have available a backup copy of their competition music either on a CD or on a cell phone and it must be immediately available rink side when the skater competes. If the phone does not have the standard round headset connector an appropriate adapter, such as an Apple Lightning connector or Samsung USB-C adapter is required to be attached. the phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode, screen unlocked and volume turned to maximum.

Awards: Awards will be given during the resurface following your event. Medals will be awarded for first through sixth place. Team Point Trophies will be presented at the end of the competition for first through third place.

Schedules: Schedules will be emailed to team coaches and competitors approximately one week prior to the competition.

Facility: Huntsville Ice Sports Center is a two-sheet facility. 1. NHL size 200x85 and 2.Olympic size 200x100

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Solo Compulsory Moves

Maneuvers will be performed with few connecting moves and minimal choreography. There should be only one attempt per element. Additional maneuvers, such as any jump, spin or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

There is no penalty given for the quantity of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers performed in the Pre-Alpha - Beta levels. Only the quality of these maneuvers is judged.

Pre-Alpha – Freestyle 5 will be on ½ ICE ONLY / Freestyle 6 – 10 will be on FULL ICE

Freestyle 10	Double Axel-Double Toe Loop jump combination / Death Drop / Three Arabian Cartwheel or Butterfly jumps

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Solo Compulsory Moves Continued

Maneuvers will be performed with few connecting moves and minimal choreography. There should be only one attempt per element. Additional maneuvers, such as any jump, spin or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

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Stroking & Jump/Spin Events

STROKING

Stroking: Alpha through Delta

Skaters compete together in groups wearing colored numbers for easy identification by the Judges. They do ONLY forward stroking in both directions and ARE judged on posture and correct stroking technique. Crossovers ARE required and will be judged.

Stroking: Freestyle 1-4 (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)

Forward at least one direction and backward at least one direction – no pattern; just turn or change directions when told. Strokes and crossovers are judged (NO CUTBACKS). (All in same event will go together and wear numbers)

Stroking: Freestyle 5 and up (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)

Forward and backward in a figure eight pattern: One figure eight forward, turn backward in center, one figure eight backward, then stop. Strokes and crossovers are judged (NO CUTBACKS). (will go one at a time; no numbers)

JUMP & SPIN:

Two skaters enter the ice as a team. The first skater performs their choice of a required jump 2 times, followed by the second skater performing their choice of a required spin 2 times. Only the best attempt of each required element will be judged. *Only the technical accuracy of the required element is judged – the difficulty of the chosen element is not considered during judging for this event.*

Low	Both skaters must be in Pre-Alpha to Delta levels only.
Bronze	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 1-3 / Bronze levels or below.
Silver	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 4-5 / Silver levels or below.
Gold	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 6-7 / Gold levels or below.
Platinum	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 8-10 / Platinum levels or below.

ALL JUMP & SPIN EVENTS will be done on ½ ICE ONLY. Category

Levels:

If two skaters from different category levels wish to compete together, the team will be entered in the highest level of the two skaters.

Platinum	Dbl. Loop or Dbl. Lutz	Flying Sit or Camel-Jump-Camel

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EVENT INFORMATION

WARM-UP TIMES

- 5 minutes: Interpretive Spotlight, Team Interpretive, Pairs, Open Freestyle, Dance
4 minutes: Figures, Artistic, Freestyle, Family Spotlight, Solo Spotlight, Couples Spotlight, Rhythmic, Team Compulsories, Tots-Delta
3 minutes: Jump & Spin (1.5 minutes for each, first jumpers then spinners), Solo Compulsories, Footwork, Ensemble
0 minutes: Stroking, Production, synchronized (built into Production and Synchro event times)

STROKING There will not be a warm-up for Stroking events.

Skaters will wear colored vests up through Freestyle 4.

Please have skaters report to the check-in area a little earlier than usual so that we can get the proper vest on each skater!

Basic level skaters will be asked to skate forward, only, but in both directions in event groups until told to stop. Remind them it is not a race! Crossovers are judged as of 9/1/22.

Freestyle 1-4 skaters will be asked to skate forward and backward around the perimeter of the rink until told to stop. All in the same event will go together. Strokes and crossovers (or cutbacks) are judged. (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)

Freestyle 5 and higher skaters will skate a Figure 8 pattern, forward and backward. One figure eight forward, Mohawk in the center ice, one figure eight backward, stop. Strokes and crossovers (or cutbacks) are judged. Will go one at a time. (This is a created event. The pattern and rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)

INTERPRETIVE SPOTLIGHT (This is a created event. The rules for this event are not found in the ISI Handbook)

1. The first skater in each warm-up event group will be asked to report to the ice monitor early to hear the music for the first time. All other skaters will hear the music during warm-up and just before they skate.
2. During warm-up, we will play music two more times for all skaters
3. All but first two skaters are taken somewhere they can't hear the music
4. While the first skater performs; second skater will sit/stand back to the ice surface, face to the wall, to hear the music one more time. Same procedure to be repeated for each additional skater in the warm-up.

Props will be available and skaters may look at them during the warm-up time- skaters may use one or more props, but they must be returned to the prop area immediately after each skater skates.

SPOTLIGHTS – PROPS

There will NOT be a curtain and space is limited. Props should only be brought in one warm up group prior to the skater's event. Props should be removed during the warm-up following each skater's events. All props will be down by the Zamboni end of the rink.
