

HUNTSVILLE ICE SPORTS CENTER COVID OPERATING PROCEDURES
Effective February 25, 2021

The Ice Sports Center is committed to everyone's safety as we continue to serve our patrons. Please read and comply with the following.

- Signage with current COVID protocol will be posted at entry point.
- Touchless hand sanitizer placed is placed at the entry/exit for everyone's use.
- Check-in with program point of contact. Facility staff and program leads are there to assist you.
- Participants are allowed 2 spectators. Siblings are required to stay with their parent at all times.
- Masks shall be worn by all persons entering and while in the facility. Hockey players, coaches, and officials actively participating in on-ice activities may remove their mask. Coaches are required to wear masks during games while on the bench.
- HSSTA skaters, spectators, and coaches are required to wear a mask. Class skaters will wear masks at all times both on and off the ice. Skaters during free skate sessions are recommended to wear masks. Masks must be worn when skater is with-in six feet of private coach or other skaters.
- Six-foot social distancing between individuals who are not from the same family unit is encouraged.
- Participants may enter 15 minutes prior to session start time and must vacate within 15 minutes after exiting the ice.
- Goalies are allowed to enter 30 minutes prior to session start time.
- Participants will be directed/escorted to designated zone/locker room upon arrival.
- Hockey players no longer are required to arrive dressed. Locker room doors may be closed for privacy.
- No use of showers in the locker rooms.
- Participants may only enter the ice at their designated start time, not before.
- All new participants and spectators must sign and submit a waiver before entering the Huntsville Ice Sports Center (ISC).

Ice Sports Center COVID-19 Exposure Plan

***Employees** are required to disclose to ISC HR if they are exposed to COVID-19 or if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 and/or tests positive for COVID-19.

If Employee is exposed to COVID-19

If you have been, or think you have been, exposed to COVID-19, it is important to stay home and away from other people. The Ice Sports Center requires an employee exposed to COVID-19 to be tested and quarantine for up to 14 days from the exposure date until test results are available. Testing can begin 5 days or later after exposure.

If Employee shows symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID-19

Employees must quarantine if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 until tested and results known.

Employees may return to work after:

- 10 days since symptoms first appeared
- No longer experiencing symptoms
- 3 days with no fever (not due to taking fever reducing medications)
- 1 negative test

If Employee tests positive for COVID-19 but has no symptoms

Employees may return to work after:

- 10 days have passed since positive test was taken

***Patrons and program participants** are required to disclose to the ISC, via their Program Director, if they are exposed to COVID-19 or if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 and/or tests positive for COVID-19.

If Patron or Participant is exposed to COVID-19

Patrons must quarantine from the rink and/or program for 14 days from the exposure date.

If Patron or Participant shows symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID-19

Patrons may return to the rink and/or program after:

- 10 days since symptoms first appeared
- No longer experiencing symptoms
- 3 days with no fever (not due to taking fever reducing medications)
- 1 negative test
